



# Photo Policy

**Anyone is free** to take pictures inside the pavilion or on the concrete apron outdoors for **personal** use. **Photographers**, however, are not permitted to take photos while riding or standing on the Carousel. Photographers, whether amateur or professional, are required to stay outside of the glass rail.

**Personal photo taking** may not significantly interrupt the flow of the Carousel's operations. Obstructing others' movement in the building or asking other riders to move seats or horses will not be allowed. We do not permit standing and moving around during the ride or holding up the following ride for extended picture taking.

**All riders and photographers** must abide by Carousel rules and staff instructions.

**If you will be using** the content for commercial purposes, including social media you will need to get a permit through the Carousel office at least one week in advance of the date you wish to shoot, or more, depending on the scope of your request.

**Without written consent**, the use of the following equipment is not permitted at any time on the Carousel, inside the pavilion or outside on the concrete apron: tripods, lighting equipment, go-pros, any camera mounted to a vehicle, drone, cart, scooter or other moving object.

**Any use, reuse or reproduction** of Carousel photos and videos for commercial purposes without the express written consent of Jane's Carousel is strictly prohibited.

**All photo shoots require the approval of Jane's Carousel.**
